Distribution of the Meat, Wool and Skin

- All parts of the Qurbani will be distributed to the poor and needy around the globe.
- The skin and wool will be used to preserve the heritage skills among the refugee communities.
- International exhibitions of the items made by the refugee communities from the Qurbani wool and skin will be organised. This will help increase awareness of this great Sunnah and how the Qurbani Project can be utilised to help refugee communities preserve their heritage and sustain a living.



Finalising the Project

Packaging

Vacuum-packed (Less than 50,000 Qurbani)

- Vacuum-packed meat, either chilled or frozen. Vacuum-packed chilled meat has a shelf life of up to 14 weeks.

Canned Meat (More than 50,000 Qurbani)

Advantages of Canned Meat:

- Long shelf life, of up to 24 months.
- Easy to transport – no need for refrigerated transport facilities.
- Can be delivered to hard to reach places, and refugee camps that do not have fridges and electricity.
- Ready to eat, with extra added vitamins and minerals, resulting in increased nutrition for the poor and needy.

The high standards of NZ processing plants allows for ease of transportation across border controls worldwide.
